- A two-factor authentication app that verifies your login identity.
- Required for accessing University resources.

Highlights

Use your phone to verify logins instantly

Prevent hackers from accessing your SIU email and accounts

- Required for accessing resources off-campus. (Most <u>student</u> resources can be accessed without VPN).


